July 30, 2001

On 073001, I, Officer Livesay, was advised at shift briefing at 0630 hours that a subject, Scott Kimball, was listed as an escapee from the Montana Pre-Release Center at 805 Colleen in Helena. Scott was reported to be driving his work truck, a 1976 Chevrolet bearing Montana license plate 5T-A7837 pea green in color and bearing the business name Hi Line Paving on the side, possibly to the Spokane Washington area.

At 0700 hours, I was dispatched to the EZ Stop Gas Station at 306 Euclid Avenue regarding a theft of money from the business. The suspect was thought to be Kimball who worked there this weekend.

Upon arrival, I met with the complainant, Clint Willoughby, who advised that when he came into work this morning about 0623 hours, he noticed that the cash was missing from the till. He further inspected and noted that both deposits from Saturday and Sunday this weekend were prepared by the previous employee, but the cash was missing. Clint noted that there is only one entrance to the business and when he arrived this morning, it was locked. It can only be locked with a key. The rest of the business was completely secure. Clint noted that it is normal procedure that at the end of business on Saturdays and Sundays, that the deposit be prepared and then transported to the EZ Stop at 3425 Hwy 12 E. The deposit for Saturday was prepared, but it was not taken to the other store. Sunday's deposit wasn't completely prepared and it also was not taken to the other store. Clint was already aware that the previous employee, Kimball, had absconded from the pre-release center. Clint suspected that Kimball used the cash for travel money to get out of the state and travel to Washington to see his wife. Clint checked the business transactions and deduced that approximately \$677.00 was taken from the business this weekend. This entailed cash from Saturday's business, Sunday's business, and the till cash. Clint advised that Scott has a key to the business and was the only employee working this weekend. He recognized Scott's handwriting on the deposit envelopes.

I then contacted the pre-release center about Scott. They advised that an escape warrant was issued last night for Scott's arrest. He was entered NCIC, and that they were trying to notify the owner of the truck that Scott was driving. I had them refer

the owner to the police department when they made contact.

Shortly thereafter, the owner, George Markovich, contacted dispatch and made arrangements to meet me at his current job-site at the High Country Travel Plaza on HWY 12 E.

I met George there who informed me that he had allowed Scott to use his company truck (aforementioned description) for work purposes only. It was arranged with the pre-release center that Scott could drive it to and from work, and that he could park it at the pre-release center when he was off. George advised that Scott had no other permission to use the truck. George requested to file a theft report regarding Scott taking the truck, and he estimated that he was headed to Spokane in order to see his wife who lives at 3119 East 44th. George advised that Scott was making statements Friday about just seeing his wife here in Helena, and that it was hard seeing her leave.

George completed a theft report and wished to pursue the theft. He estimated the value of the truck itself at about \$800.00, however, George had a Norton Clipper Concrete/Asphalt saw in the back which he had rented recently. George had already contacted the rental agency, and they advised that he was responsible for the saw which values today at \$1,750.00. George also advised that he is responsible for rental of the saw at \$50.00 a day until it is returned.

George and I responded to MP&E rental and obtained the make, model, and serial number for the saw.

At this time, an ATL has been broadcast for Scott and the truck. I had dispatch update this ATL indicating that the truck and saw are listed in NCIC as stolen. I also conferred with the County Attorney's office about Felony MV Theft charges against Scott. Lisa Leckie with the CA's office agreed, and I am forwarding a copy of this report with a request for a warrant for Scott's arrest on the associated thefts.
