



On May 15, 2003, the Department of Corrections submitted a Notice of Violation Report to the Court charging Mr. Kimball with failing to report to the Washington State Department of Corrections following his release from Alaska authorities on or about 12/18/02 and failing to make payments toward his Court-ordered legal financial obligations.

The Department of Corrections recommended the Court issue a warrant for the arrest of Mr. Kimball, which the Court granted and issued the warrant on 5/27/03.

Mr. Kimball was subsequently arrested on the warrant by FBI Agent Carl Schloff in Denver, Colorado. On 6/18/03, I received a call from Agent Schloff who reported that he had met with Mr. Kimball in jail and was informed by Mr. Kimball that he had knowledge of a murder that had occurred in the Denver area.

Mr. Kimball reported that he was acquainted with some individuals who were involved in dealing drugs and these individuals believed a female acquaintance was providing information to the Drug Enforcement Administration so they murdered her. Mr. Kimball further reported that he saw a photograph of the female that showed her bound and duct taped. In addition, he claimed he was told the body was dumped in the woods near Vail, Colorado and that one of the


individuals involved in the murder asked Mr. Kimball if he would be willing to go to where they dumped the body and remove the body's breast implants and intrauterine device.

Agent Schloff is requesting that the bench warrant issued on 5/2/03 be quashed so Mr. Kimball can re-establish contact with the individuals who informed him of the murder, in an attempt to get the body's exact location. Agent Schloff assured me if the warrant is quashed, he will do everything he can to assure Mr. Kimball appears for any scheduled court date to address the alleged violations of his supervision.

The STATE moved the court for an order quashing and recalling the bench warrant issued in this case, per CCS: Todd Wiggs. See attached special dated 6/20/03.


II. FINDING


