On 07-15-04 at 2129 hours, I responded to a radio call to assist medical at 14701 Huron Street. Dispatch advised that a female party (later identified as Lori McLeod) had called "911" and said her 10-year-old son had broken his leg. Lori McLeod said that her husband (Scott Kimball) was already transporting the child by private vehicle to an unknown hospital. The female also said she was not sure what happened because the incident occurred behind the house, however there was "blood in the front of the house".

I arrived at 2142 hours and first attempted contact at the front house which displays 14701 Huron Street. No one answered the front door and the house appeared to be empty. I did not see any blood at the front of the house. From previous calls for service at this location, I remembered there is a rental house on the west side of the main house and walked around the house to it. On the front porch, I saw a five inch puddle of blood surrounded by blood spatters about 3 feet from the front door. There was no answer at the door. I began a neighborhood canvas and spoke to an unknown man at 14741 Huron Street. He advised that he had not seen or heard anything but when asked, he said that the closest hospital would be either North Suburban Hospital or Avista in Louisville. I requested that dispatch call Avista. Dispatch did re-contact Lori McLeod there and learned that the child had been playing on a metal grate which had fallen on him and injured him. I searched the entire area. In a pasture on the west side of the property, I found a 10' X 3' very heavy (about 200 pounds) metal grate laying on the ground. I saw blood on the ground in the weeds on the east side of the grate. Also on the ground were 2 soda cans, a shovel and a flashlight. Leaning on the front of an unused flat-bed truck was a pitch fork and on its hood was an opened soda can. Leaning on the front of another unused pick-up truck was a broom.

I photographed the overall area, the blood on the front porch, the overall area of the pasture, the grate and the blood in the weeds. I submitted the film to our lab for processing.

Sergeant T.J. Coates requested that Detectives respond to the hospital to interview the parents. Detective M. Lekic responded to Avista Hospital and Detective J. Stevens responded to the scene.

When Detectives arrived, I learned that [REDACTED], his brother [REDACTED] and their father, Scott Kimball were in the pasture with the intention of building a mouse trap. Scott sent [REDACTED] inside to get some sodas then also went inside to get some gloves. While they were away, [REDACTED] attempted to climb the steel grate which was propped up lengthwise against the side of the flatbed truck. The grate tipped over onto [REDACTED], cutting the back of his head. Scott heard the crash and [REDACTED] screams and ran to him. Scott pulled the grate off of [REDACTED], flipping it over toward the west. Scott decided to transport [REDACTED] himself because there has been jurisdictional problems in the past when calling "911". (Scott said a recent call to 911 for a camper fire resulted in a seventeen minute response time) Scott carried [REDACTED] to the car and told Lori to call "911". While en route to the hospital, [REDACTED] began flailing around and saying that he could not breathe. In an attempt to open the window, [REDACTED] opened the door of the Jeep Cherokee and fell out of the vehicle. Scott reached for [REDACTED] but was unable to grab anything but his sandal, which came off in his hand. Scott said his speed at the time was about 70 miles per hour, however, Police said it could have been as slow as 45 miles per hour. Scott turned around very quickly because he was afraid [REDACTED] would be hit by other vehicles that he had just passed. Again Scott placed [REDACTED] into the front, passenger seat of the Jeep and continued to the hospital. Avista Hospital advised that [REDACTED] was in critical condition and was airlifted to Children's Hospital in Denver. At 0312 hours, [REDACTED] was still in surgery.

Louisville Police Officers and Boulder County Sheriff's Deputies were both called to Avista. Louisville Police filed report number 04-1797 and Boulder filed number 04-4259.
