| <p>On 8-9-05 at about 2342 hours, as a result of a radio call, contacted Scott Kimball via telephone. When I contacted Mr. Kimball, He kept referring to me as Brett, even though I identified myself three times as Deputy Tim Phillips of the Adams County Sheriff's Office. Mr. Kimball finally said "good she is gone". Mr. Kimball then explained that he is the protected person of an Adams County no-contact bond (case number 05M2417) and that his estranged wife Lori Kimball is the restrained party of the bond. Mr. Kimball said that his wife of three years was recently arrested for 3rd degree assault domestic violence. Deputy Arntzen on CR # 05-10362 made that arrest.</p> <p>Mr. Kimball further explained that he referred to me as Brett, because Mrs. Kimball was sitting right next to him in her car. He said that Brett is his brother and that he did not want Mrs. Kimball to know that he was talking to a cop. He said that he was in fear that Mrs. Kimball may have had weapons in her car and that if she knew he was talking to a cop she may harm him.</p> <p>He explained that he has livestock in the area of the 15000 block of Lowell Blvd and that he goes there every night to care for the livestock. The 15000 block of Lowell Blvd is in the City and County of Broomfield. Around 2300 hours when he arrived tonight he found Mrs. Kimball waiting in her car in the field where the livestock are. Mr. Kimball is routinely there at that time and it was reasonable that Mrs. Kimball could expect him to be there.</p> <p>Mrs. Kimball talked to him about changing his testimony in regards to her domestic violence charges. She told him that he needed to tell the District Attorney's Office that he was off of his meds at the time of her domestic violence arrest. According to Mr. Kimball this is due to a strategy that was suggested to her by her attorney. She also told him that if he did not change his testimony she would call members of his family and friends and tell them lies about him. It was at about this time that I initially called Mr. Kimball on his cell phone and he pretended that I his brother. Mrs. Kimball then drove away.</p> <p>Mr. Kimball then told me that Mrs. Kimball told him that she would go to their house at 14701 Huron St, to wait for him. Mr. Kimball told me Mrs. Kimball was driving a gray Jeep Grand Cherokee bearing Colorado plate # 288-INP. While on the line with Mr. Kimball, he received several phone calls on call waiting. Every time he stated that it was Mrs. Kimball calling him. Mr. Kimball later showed me on his cell phone that Mrs. Kimball called him 47 times between 2158 hours and 2357 hours. Some of these calls were received at the Huron address and others were received while he was traveling.</p> <p>I told Mr. Kimball to stay at the livestock pasture and wait for me to respond to the Huron address. I then pulled a hard copy of the Temporary Protection order from Records and responded to the Huron Address with Deputies Thede, Riggins, and Jenkins. Once there we observed the gray Jeep parked next to the house. The engine compartment of the Jeep was still hot to the touch. I then looked around the house, I noticed a light on in the bedroom. I could also see a female matching the description of Mrs. Kimball sitting on the bed. The female appeared to be talking on a cell phone.</p> <p>I requested that Dispatch call Mr. Kimball and have him respond to the address. When Mr. Kimball arrived, I confirmed that Mr. Kimball was still a resident of the house. He said that he was, citing that he still had a large quantity of personal belongings in the residence. Mr. Kimball then allowed us to enter the residence. While talking to Mr. Kimball, Mrs. Kimball called his cell phone at least three times back to back.</p> <p>Once the door of the residence was opened, I identified myself and ordered any occupants of the house to identify themselves. There was no response. Deputy Jenkins and I then entered the house and continuously identified myself. Once in the kitchen I heard the female party shout to him from the bedroom. She then came to the bedroom door. I asked the female if she was Lori Kimball. She said that she was. I then took her into custody.</p> <p>Mrs. Kimball was slightly uncooperative when being handcuffed. She tried to spin away from me when I applied the first</p> | | | | | | | | |

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handcuff. After being completely cuffed she then began to shout that she was naked, even though she was wearing a pair of blue shorts and a red tank top shirt. I found a pair of sweat pants and helped her put them on. Mrs. Kimball then began to accuse us of forcing entry illegally into her home. I told her that her husband gave us permission. When Deputy Jenkins was walking her to the front of the house, he accidentally stepped on the back of one of her flip-flop sandals. She immediately accused him of stepping on her foot and injuring her.

I tried to speak to Mrs. Kimball. She was very agitated and argumentive. She was placed in the back seat of a patrol car. She shouted at us that we were out of control and that we were falsely arresting her. I explained to her that the only person out of control was her and that she needed to calm down. Due to the scene that she was making we put her in the back of a patrol car.

Once in the back seat of the car I verbally advised her of her Miranda Warning. She stated that she wanted to waive her Miranda Rights and make a statement. I then asked her if she was aware that she was not allowed at the residence. She stated that her attorney said that she could be there, because Mr. Kimball was moving out. I then told her that regardless of what her attorney said, the Temporary Protection Order needed to be modified to show she could live at the address. She said that she did have a modification. A check of the folder where Mrs. Kimball said the modification would be; revealed no such paper work.

While I was speaking with Mr. Kimball by the street, Deputy Thede advised me that Mrs. Kimball was complaining that her heart was racing and her blood pressure was rising. He called for an ambulance to check her out. North Metro Fire and Rescue responded and felt that she was in no kind of medical emergency and that she could be transported to jail.

The copy I had of the Temporary Protection Order showed that Mrs. Kimball is not to come within 200 yards of Mr. Kimball and to stay away from the residence of the protected party. The listed address was 74701 Huron St. Common sense led me to believe that since 74701 Huron St. did not exist and neither party had any ties to that address, a typographical error was made when entering the Temporary Protection Order into the CCIC system. The order also shows that Mrs. Kimball is allowed to make phone contact with Mr. Kimball, but may not harass or annoy him.

Due to the fact that the 15000 block of Lowell Blvd is located in Broomfield I contacted the Broomfield Police Department. I asked them to respond to the scene. Officer E. Fredrick responded. I explained the situation to him. He felt that since the harassing phone calls were linked to the Huron address that the violation that occurred on Lowell was part of a single continuing criminal episode. He stated that since both locations were located within the 17th Judicial District that the DA's office would not take two separate charges for the same incident. He did not wish to take part in the investigative activities that were occurring at the Huron address. He informed me that he would be initiating an incident report and would consult with his investigations division in the morning. Broomfield Police Department's case number is 05222000

On scene, Deputy Phillips advised me that the suspect, Lori Kimball, was restrained from being at the residence. Deputy Phillips contacted Lori Kimball inside the residence and placed her into custody. When Deputy Phillips placed her into custody, she was wearing green shorts and a red tank top. She complained loudly that she was naked and that her crotch was showing. Deputy Phillips retrieved a pair of black sweat pants from her bedroom and allowed her to put them on. He also allowed her to put on a pair of black sandals. Deputy Jenkins escorted Lori out of the residence. While escorting her through the dark entry way, Deputy Jenkins appeared to step on the back of her right sandal. The step appeared accidental, but Lori began complaining that Deputy Jenkins was trying to break her ankle. Lori was placed into the back of Deputy Jenkins patrol car. She began to complain a short time later that she felt sick and that she needed her blood pressure medicine. Medical was called at 0116 hours.  On 080905 at 2358 hours, I responded to 14701 Huron St., Thornton, CO 80230, to cover a Deputy Phillips, at the address, on a reported violation of a protection order. On arrival, I saw that Lori Kimball was inside the residence's northwest bedroom and talking on a cell phone.
 Deputy Phillips and I made contact with Lori Kimball and Deputy Phillips took her into custody. At the time that Lori Kimball was taken into custody she was wearing a red tank-top shirt and a pair of blue boxer shorts. Lori Kimball was allowed to put on a pair of sweatpants and a pair of sandals. While I was walking Lori Kimball out of the house she stopped walking and I stepped on her right sandal with my left foot. Lori Kimball then said, "You are stomping on my ankle and trying to break my foot." I then told Lori Kimball that I had accidentally stepped onto her sandal. After we had exited the house Lori Kimball said, "I can't believe you brought me out here naked." I told Lori Kimball that I did not know what she was talking about because she was fully clothed. Lori Kimball did not respond to my comment.
 Lori Kimball began to complain that she was feeling sick and that she needed her medicine for high blood pressure. Adcom was contacted to request an ambulance. An ambulance arrived on scene and medically cleared Lori Kimball for jail. Deputy Phillips then transported Lori Kimball to the Adams County Sheriff's Office Sub-station for processing.
 There is no further information at this time.
