C: Deputy's Investigation:								
<p>On 07-09-05 at about 0850 hours I was dispatched to Rocky Mountain All Natural Beef, Inc., 801 S Public Road in Lafayette, CO, to assist Lafayette Police, in reference to a physical domestic which occurred at 14701 N Huron Street. When I arrived on scene, I spoke to Scott Kimball inside of the business. Scott told me the following information:</p> <p>Scott Kimball and Lori Kimball have been married for the last two years, but they had not had any children together. Scott and Lori have lived together at the above address during their marriage.</p> <p>On 07-09-05 at about 0530 hours, Scott and Lori got into an argument at their residence. Lori began yelling at Scott and calling him a "pussy." Lori continued to yell and swear at Scott, so Scott went into the bathroom to take a shower. After Scott was finished with his shower, he tried to exit the bathroom but Lori met him at the door. Lori was pointing her finger at Scott, and she continued to yell at him. Lori then picked up an upright vacuum that was leaning up against the wall outside of the bathroom. The vacuum was not plugged in and the cord to the vacuum was coiled up on the vacuum. Lori threw the vacuum at Scott and she hit him in the lower left leg. Scott did have a small scratch with dried blood on it on the lower part of his left leg. Scott told me the injury did hurt, and the area around the injury was beginning to bruise. After Lori threw the vacuum, she told Scott, "I'll kill you. You're gonna die." Scott then finished getting ready for work, but when Scott was getting into his Ford F-350 pickup, Lori keyed the passenger side of the pickup. Lori left multiple scratch marks on the passenger side of the pickup. The scratch marks were not deep, and they did not go through the entire layer of outer white paint on the pickup. After keying Scott's pickup, Lori went to the side of the house and picked up a red, Coleman grill that Scott uses for his business. Lori threw the grill on the ground, but Scott did not know if there was damage caused to the grill. Lori then went back over to Scott's pickup and keyed the passenger side of the tailgate. Lori then got into her Jeep Cherokee and blocked the driveway so Scott could not leave for work. Scott backed his pickup up so he could turn to avoid a rock wall, and he then went out through the pasture behind his house. Scott did not know what the total cost would be to repair the paint on his pickup, but the deductible for his insurance was \$250.00.</p> <p>After Scott left his residence, Lori called him on his cell phone. Lori told Scott that she was going to Lafayette to "destroy things" at his business. Scott did write a statement detailing the incident.</p> <p>I then spoke to Lori Kimball, who was outside of the business sitting in a chair, and she told me the following:</p> <p>Lori was in an argument with Scott, because she was unhappy that Scott's mother wanted her to work for \$10.00 per hour. Lori ran a lemonade stand for Scott's mother in Vail, CO. Lori felt the items used to run the lemonade stand belonged to her, even though Scott's mother paid for the items through her business. Lori was also angry with Scott, because he had the lemonade stand items locked in trailer. Scott would not give the items back to Lori, because the items belonged to the business. Lori attempted to take the Coleman grill, because she did not want Scott or his mother to use it for the business. Lori also thought that she would get the lemonade stand items back if she took the Coleman grill. Lori did admit to keying Scott's pickup, because she felt he tried to "ram" her when he was trying to leave the residence. Lori felt Scott was threatening her when he tried to "ram" her with his pickup. After I spoke to Lori, she also wrote a statement.</p> <p>Photographs of the damage done to the Ford pickup and of Scott's injuries were taken while I was on scene. I was unable to take photographs of the grill or vacuum, because those items were at the residence on Huron Street. Scott did take a photograph of the grill</p>

with his cellular phone. After the photographs were taken and the necessary paperwork was filled out, Lori was taken into custody for 3rd Degree Assault, Criminal Mischief, and Domestic Violence. Lori was then transported to the substation for processing, and she was read her Miranda Rights while at the substation. Lori was then transported to the Adams County Detention Facility.
